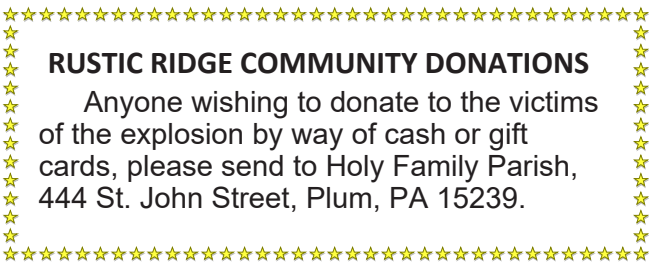

### FAITH FIRST TEACHER AND AIDES NEEDED

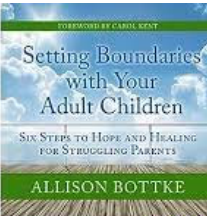

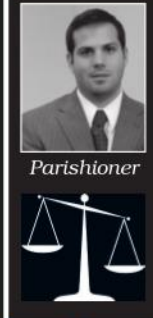

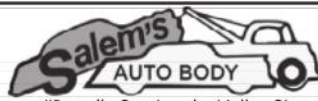
