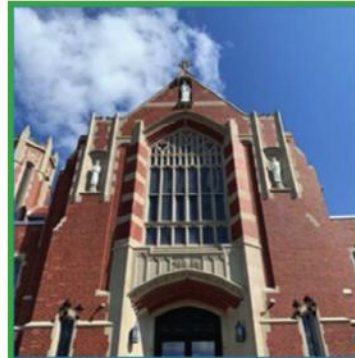

MARIAN CONSECRATION 2023

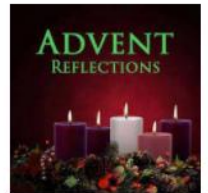
Dear Marian Travelers,
